Non-UIC students must apply to UIC following instructions in the Application for Admission and the current Undergraduate Catalog.

The College of Engineering has a higher tuition differential than most other colleges. Being admitted as an Intercollege Transfer Student will usually result in a higher tuition bill.

The admission requirements for a current UIC student is a minimum GPA of 2.5 for Illinois resident (as defined in UIC Undergraduate Catalog) and 2.75 for nonresident. Both UIC cumulative GPA, and the GPA for science and math courses, must be met. The minimum required coursework needed to be completed before being accepted into the College of Engineering is Calculus I for non-Computer Science applicants. For Computer Science applicants, Calculus I and a first level Computer Science course equivalent to CS 111 is required.

Each petition will be reviewed on an individual basis, and admission will be based on space available in the Engineering major chosen by the student, the student's overall academic record, progress in relevant science and math courses, and the student's demonstrated potential for success in the Engineering major. Admission requirements are subject to change and meeting the minimum GPA and course requirements are not a guarantee for admission. You will be informed of the decision by mail.
